- The Corrections Committee reports that there are 12 meetings/ month going into Barnstable House of Corrections. District also purchased 2 cases of books (Big Books and 12 & 12s) for the jail. We welcome Jules, who was elected as our new Chairperson at the December meeting. She has experience, connections to the jail and resources. It promises to be an exciting year!
